

## Job Description – Maintenance Technician

### Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Perform inspection, maintenance and repair to industrial production machinery or equipment in a foundry environment.
- Cooperate with supervisors, machine operators and other maintenance personnel in troubleshooting and repair of production equipment.
- Respond to needs for immediate repair of production equipment.
- Perform routine maintenance such as inspecting motors, belts, drives, replacing filters, etc. and other preventative maintenance actions.
- Inspect, repair, replace, install, adjust, and maintain all mechanical equipment in the foundry environment.
- Trouble shoot and repair all types of plant and production equipment (electrical, hydraulic, pneumatic, mechanical, etc.)
- Participate in continuous improvement activities.
- Troubleshoot and ensure machine uptime on overhead cranes, sand mixers, conveyors, and other foundry equipment.
- Have the ability to work independently as well as collaborate and work with other co-workers at all levels of the organization.
- Maintain a safe work environment for maintenance personnel and ensure compliance with safety regulations.

### Essential Physical Functions:

- Ability to work in manufacturing environment.
- Ability to work long hours while standing or operating equipment.
- Ability to work in high temperatures at times.
- Ability to move/lift objects and materials of at least 40 lbs.
